SUPPORTING TRAVEL TO THE 2018 EORTC CUTANEOUS LYMPHOMA TASK FORCE (CLTF) MEETING



The Cutaneous Lymphoma Foundation is pleased to announce that it is soliciting applications for its Young Investigator Award, which supports travel to the 2018 European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer (EORTC) CLTF meeting to be held September 27-29, 2018 in St. Gallen, Switzerland.

This award, a \$1,500 honorarium, will support travel of a young investigator who is attending the EORTC CLTF Meeting and is presenting cutaneous lymphoma related research.

Criteria for selection of the Young Investigator Award includes:

- Individuals with a M.D. or Ph.D. degree.
- Individuals with an academic rank no greater than assistant professor.
- Individuals with demonstrable interest and/or achievement in clinical care, education or research in cutaneous lymphomas.
- Individuals who have submitted an abstract and will presenting research at the 2018 EORTC CLTF meeting.
