



An automatic e-mail will be sent to you allowing you to **reset** your password

*On-line Randomized Trials Access (**ORTA**) credentials are sent as automatic e-mail message from Randlog@eortc.org to your inbox (or spam folder).

First time login will prompt you to **immediately change your password; afterwards, you are asked to update **every 3 months**. Do **not** use accents in your password.

How navigate in ORTA? (1)

Enter EORTC institution number

Click on 'Details' to open the EORTC clinical trial page with trial details after entry of the protocol number

Enter EORTC protocol number (i.e., 4 or 5 digits)


Enter the 'name' and 'first name' of the responsible physician or select the responsible physician from the 'List'

Enter a unique 'Patient code' or select the existing subject from the 'List':

- Alphanumeric (Max. 4 characters)
- Cannot start with a numeric value
- No initials

Enter the 'Patient birth date' in DD/MM/YYYY format.

The dropdown list 'Step' allows you to register a new subject ('1 - New patient'), continue next steps with registered subjects ('x - Existing patient') or blinded treatment allocation of registered subjects ('Resupply treat.') according to the protocol setting




Opens an overview of the enrolled subjects.
