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Following several years of working with cancer pathways in the NHS and helping to deliver cancer research studies, Dr Louis Fox studied his PhD in behavioural science, designing a physical activity intervention for men with prostate cancer. Currently, he leads on a portfolio of international, multi-site studies related to health-related quality of life in cancer, within the Transforming cancer Outcomes through Research (TOUR) team.

His expertise encompasses both qualitative and quantitative analytical methods. His current areas of focus are the delivery of prospective studies to develop and validate health-related quality of life measures in the context of cancer survivorship and immunotherapy and examining how to upgrade supportive care pathways to support health-related quality of life needs for men with testicular cancer post-treatment. He has also been involved with initiatives to support resilience of cancer research systems globally in the wake of the outbreaks of the COVID pandemic and the war in Ukraine.
